A Message from the CEO

Dr. Gary L. Jones

“With man this is impossible, but with God, all things are possible.” – Matthew 19:26



This verse comes to mind as I sit back and look at all that has been accomplished in 2024. We are truly amazed at the many examples of how we serve a faithful God, whose “hand” is surely upon us with His grace, His protection, and His abundant provision.

We have served more children, adults, and families in 2024 than any single year in our history. With opening two new homes midyear – the JD Gibbs and Coy Gibbs Homes – we have served 1,017 residents this year alone!! Think about this – it took YFT 20 years to serve our 1,000th resident, Now, in 2024, we served more than who we served in the first 20 years of our residential program.

With our seven Regional Offices, we have served 7,554 behavioral health outpatient clients this year alone. 26% of them being children under age 12.

Each one of these residents and clients require a “blueprint” or a treatment plan to give both the therapist and the recipient a “roadmap” to healing, to hope, and to moving forward. This means that our staff wrote a total of 8,571 treatment plans in 2024 to serve our residents and clients across our various programs. It takes intelligence, patience, forgiveness, leadership, and acquired skills by our professional staff in programs and ancillary departments to carry out these essential services.

Each of our high-quality staff go through rigorous training and come with varied experiences, often catching the attention of outside boards and agencies. Therefore, it is with no surprise that two of our staff have been appointed by Governor Youngkin to sit on Boards serving the Commonwealth. Additionally, Youth For Tomorrow was presented with the “Spirit of Virginia” award from Governor Youngkin. This remarkable honor speaks volumes to the community of who we

are at YFT – but just as important – speaks volumes of encouragement to our staff of the amazing work they are doing for our children and clients, in the name of the Lord.

On the business side, as we aim to be good stewards of what is entrusted to us, Youth For Tomorrow is now debt-free, for the first time in our 39 year history, and only by the grace of God! The YFT Foundation voted to resolve the remainder of the mortgage on the YFT property. Additionally, our programs have worked towards getting close to balancing their program budgets – which has helped us reach yet another balanced budget – 27 of the last 28 years!

It is because of your faithful support and generosity that we are able to not only meet budget – but continue to grow and serve more children, more adults, and more families each year – who otherwise, would continue to face desperation and despair without our services.

As we praise the Lord for all He has done on our campus and across our Regional Offices, we most certainly praise the Lord for YOU – our faithful supporters, our faithful donors, ambassadors in the Northern VA community and our faithful prayer warriors. Thank you for being a part of our mission, our accomplishments, and our YFT family.

May the Lord greatly bless each of you and your family as we embark upon a new year.

ALL homes were “winners” with \$100 awarded for the residents to go on an outing. These homes listed to the right received special recognition and \$200 for outings.

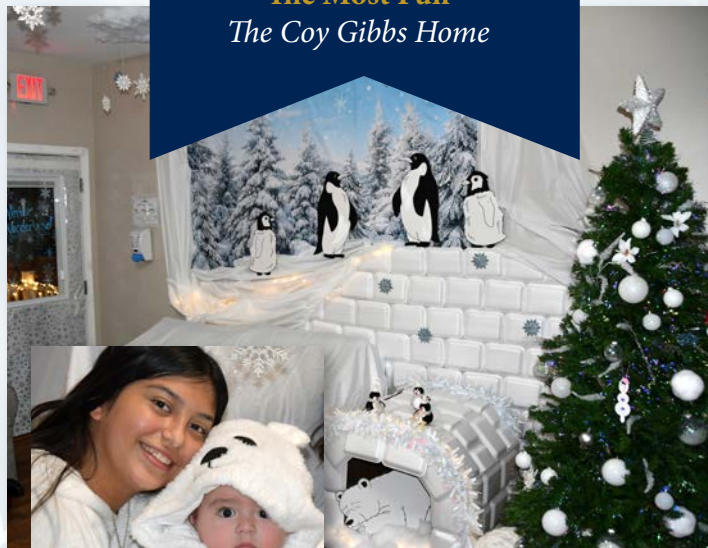

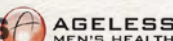
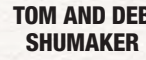
