

of any genre to debut an album at No. 1 on the all-genre Billboard Top 200 Albums chart with his Platinum-certified album, *Clear as Day*.

He won the 10th season of *American Idol* in 2011 at 17. That same year, he was named ACM New Artist of the Year. McCreery has won two CMT Music Awards: the first for the category, Breakthrough Video of the Year for "The Trouble with Girls" in 2012. His second award was for the category Digital-First Performance of the Year for "It Matters to Her" from *CMT Stages* in 2024.

Scotty has also received BMI Awards for writing one of the Top 50 Country Songs of the Year five times: in 2015 for "See You Tonight," in 2018 for "Five More Minutes," in 2019 for "This is It," in 2021 for "In Between," and in 2022 for "You Time."

His latest album, *Rise & Fall*, features his sixth No. 1 single, "Cab in a Solo," and his current single

"Fall of Summer" with an additional 11 songs. In this project, McCreery explores classic themes such as heartbreak, rowdy nights, nostalgia, faith, newfound joy, fatherhood, and enduring love. Throughout it all, he felt comfortable being himself, resulting in a collection characterized by electrifying twang, rich baritone vocals, and insightful storytelling.

You Time

At 31 years old, McCreery has sold over 4 million albums and has achieved six No. 1 hits. These include "Cab in a Solo," the RIAA Platinumcertified "Damn Strait," the RIAA Gold-certified "You Time," the RIAA Gold-certified "In Between," the RIAA Platinum-certified "This is It," and the RIAA Triple Platinum-certified "Five More Minutes."





The North Carolina native boasts one Triple Platinum, five Platinum, and four Gold singles; one Platinum and two Gold albums. He was awarded Pandora Billionaire status in 2021 in recognition of his music achieving more than one billion streams on Pandora. His song "Five More Minutes" inspired two popular holiday movies which aired on the Hallmark Movies & Mysteries Network: Five More Minutes in 2021 and Five More Minutes: Moments Like These in 2022. He released his first book "Go Big or Go Home: The Journey Toward the Dream" in 2016.

In October of 2023, Scotty was inducted into the North Carolina Music Hall of Fame. 



CIVIL WAR BRASS MOUNTED PERCUSSION RIFLED MUSKET

This original .58 caliber, percussion rifle musket is a fine Model 1861 contract percussion musket produced by the Parker, Snow Company of Meriden, Connecticut. The same Parker Snow company that then went on to become the infamous Parker Bros. Shotgun Company. This musket is rare in that it is all original, never replaced or refurbished,



a true anomaly for a musket of its service magnitude. This musket has a 40" barrel mated to a black walnut stock. The lock plate is stamped with a large spread winged eagle over "U.S." and marked "PARKERS' SNOW & CO. / MERIDEN, CONN" in front of the hammer. This marking is believed to be the product of the James Mulholland contract of 1861 of which only 5,500 such muskets were delivered to the government and would represent the first venture in firearms manufacturing by Charles Parker of Meriden. The date of "1863" is stamped back of this particular musket making it one of only 500 produced in



the year 1863. Musket comes complete with its three original barrel bands, hammer, bolster, lock plate and screws, rear / front sight, both swivels and its swelled shank ramrod. The stock retains its original finish and deep, rich patina. There are the usual dings and scrapes from age and normal use. Visible on the flat opposite the hammer are two government inspector's cartouches. Bore is clean and bright. An exceptional piece of United States Military history!

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES



Youth For Tomorrow's Outpatient Behavioral Health Services meets an urgent need in the community to prevent hospitalization, reduce suicides and addiction and improve the overall mental health care for children, adolescents and adults while providing a safe place for hope and healing.

YFT has evolved into one of the premier providers in Northern Virginia, specifically known for serving children, adolescents and families. We provide services for the uninsured and under insured populations in both English and Spanish. We assist with Medicaid enrollment, accept Medicaid and Medicare along with private insurances. Also, we provide sliding scale sessions for those in need of financial assistance. On average 47% of our clients are on Medicaid and 62% are under 18.

Our clinical staff includes psychiatrists, psychiatric nurse practitioners, psychologists, licensed clinicians, and therapists. In FY24, YFT provided outpatient behavioral health services to 6,608 individuals with a cumulative total of approximately 36,880 counseling sessions.

Statistically, 62% of our patients are under the age of 18, and 17% of that number are under the age of 10. YFT provides play therapy treatment for children ages 5 – 12. Our highest population served is middle and high school students and then elementary school aged children, along with college students and then adults.

We work with all the major hospital systems in Northern VA including Sentara, UVA and Inova. We work closely with schools in the four counties we serve, Fairfax, Fauquier, Loudoun and Prince William along with social services, community service boards, primary care providers and pediatricians and other community partners.

YFT holds the highest level of national accreditation among programs providing behavioral health care clinical services, being awarded accreditation from The Joint Commission (Oakbrook Terrace, IL.), which evaluates health care organizations throughout the nation for their standards of care. YFT's behavioral health services is also accredited by the Council on Accreditation (COA). YFT is licensed by the Virginia Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services (DBHDS), the Virginia Department of Social Services (DSS) and the Virginia Department of Education (DOE).

By his own admission, Jeff Bevins was a "troubled young man" when he arrived at YFT in 1996. Lack of strong family support sent him on the path of despair. Facing what seemed like endless years in the juvenile legal system, he was offered a final chance to get his life back on track and to enter YFT.

He credits Dr. Terry Tinsley for "taking him under his wing". Jeff also recalls focusing on a sign that hung inside the Hazel Home for Boys which read, "Change Your Life."

Part of his change was taking his spirituality seriously, which wasn't the case prior to coming to YFT. He recalls fondly "we prayed a lot - we went to church a lot - and it brought me happiness. YFT also taught you the value of work, it taught me to be a man."

As he looks back on his time spent at Youth For Tomorrow, Aaron marvels at the growth of the campus. "When I was here ('91-'92) they only had one home -- the Hazel Home for boys. The Chapel wasn't here, the school building wasn't here, and we had a trailer in the back where we went to school," Stone said.

In 1991, when Aaron was a teen, he was struggling with authority, didn't go to school, and admitted he "pretty much did what I wanted." YFT changed the direction of his life. A good student prior to straying off course as an adolescent, he regrouped academically at YFT, and found a deeper meaning to his life.

Aaron credits Mr. William A. Hazel who had mentored him while at YFT and instilled a desire to enter the construction field. For the past 20 years, Aaron has been employed by William A Hazel Inc. Construction as a Superintendent. He fondly recalls, "YFT is here to give you a chance. Looking back, I wouldn't be here today if it wasn't for this place."
